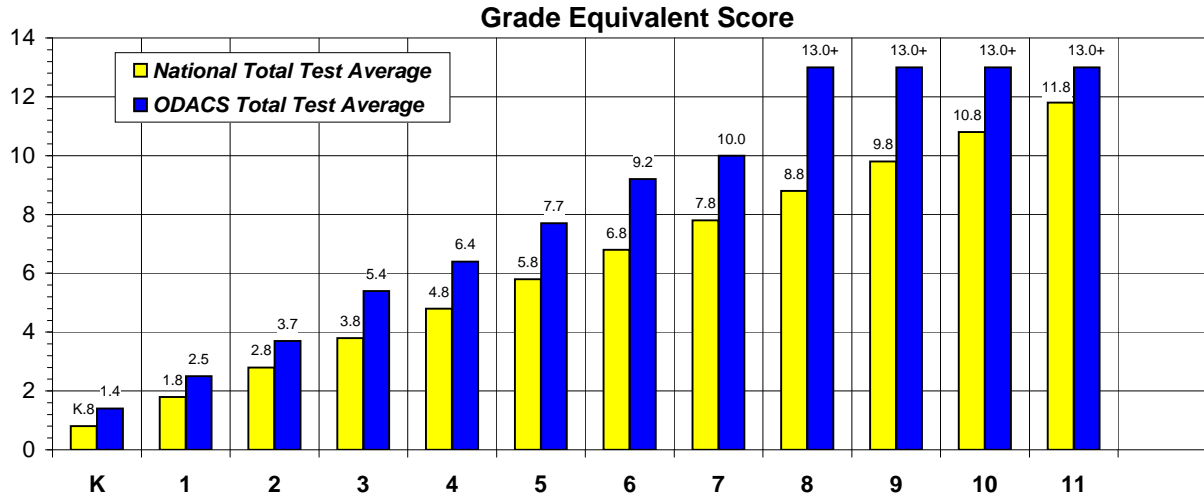


Old Dominion Association of Church Schools' Students Score Higher Than The National Average!

2010 - 2011 School Year

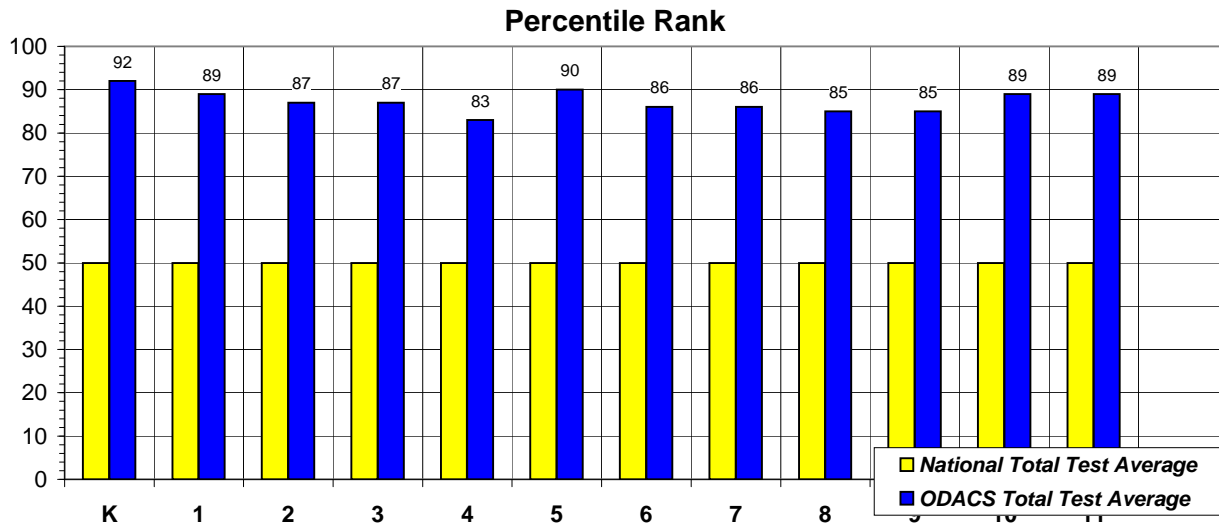
Annual achievement testing shows that ODACS State Association students score higher than the National Average at every grade level tested.
