REGIONAL ON-SITE TESTING

Dear Administrator and Test Proctor:

This year all academic testing and creative writing for all four regional competitions will be done on-site at your school prior to the main competition day. Attached are the instructions for on-site Bible and academic testing. Please read through the instructions and make the necessary preparations. If you have any questions, please call the ODACS Office.

Please note these important rules changes that took effect in 2016!

- ***Old Testament Bible Knowledge*** and ***New Testament Bible Knowledge*** have been moved to ***Area Five: Academics***.
- ***A student may now enter two Academic categories***, so long as they are not both Writing categories for both Science Fair categories. This means that an individual contestant may now take two tests. ***The new rule applies to all three levels of competition (Elementary, Junior High, and Senior High)!***

Contestant registration forms for testing and creative writing are also attached. *Please note that these forms are due in the ODACS office by February 14!* Contestant registration forms for the rest of the competition categories will be sent separately very soon. After you have submitted your testing/creative writing contestant registrations, you will receive your tests and answer sheets along with another copy of the Test Proctor Instructions a few days prior to on-site testing. Following are the on-site testing target dates for each region. There is flexibility; if the published date does not work well for your school, please contact me with an alternative date.

North Region Elementary – February 21
Mountain Region – February 28
East Region – March 7
Central Region – March 7
North Region, Levels II and III – March 7

Please be certain to note the announcement prohibiting students from bringing cell phones or other electronic devices into the testing room.
